ABOLISH WEST POINT KILL THE HAZERS.

Sentiments of Messrs. Allen and Money Expressed in the Senate.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Jan. 16.—Bitter denunciations of hazing at West Point were uttered in the United States Senate to-day in the discussion of the Army bill.

Senator Allen declared that either hazing should be suppressed or the Military Academy abolished. Its suppression he believed easily possible.

"The most brutal indignities," he declared, "take place with the full knowledge of the officers in charge. Investigation is stifled and inquiries suppressed." The cadets he characterized as "ragamuffins."

"Give an old volunteer officer authority over West Point," he said, "and hazing will be stopped in six weeks or there'll be some dead boys there."

Speaking of class fights, he maintained that the man who used superior brute strength against a weakling was a coward.

"Stop hazing," said he, "or let every State have its own military school and educate its own officers."

Senator Money, interrupting Senator Allen, vowed that if he were a young man at West Point, and the cadets there treated him with the inhuman indignities reported, he would kill his persecutors.
